

Coronach 100th Anniversary – FAQ

What types of tickets are there, and what do they include?

There are 2 types of weekend passes. One includes the Sunday night concert and one does not. Besides that, both tickets get you entry into all other events. Some activities or vendors may have additional costs.

Your weekend pass includes admission to:

- All concerts and cabarets
- All entertainment taking place in the Sportsplex
- The Kids Zone

The Church Service and Pancake Breakfasts are open to everyone and do not require a weekend ticket. No food is included with your ticket.

The tradeshow is open to the public for free. The Big Muddy Players Show admission is \$10.

The pool and golf course will be open to everyone with their regular fees.

There is a 3rd ticket option strictly for the Sunday night concert. For this ticket you may come to the Sportsplex at 4 PM.

Is there a single-day ticket option?

No, just weekend passes. There is a ticket option strictly for the Sunday night concert.

Are there different ticket prices for adults, youth, and children?

Yes. We offer several ticket types for weekend passes based on age. Please select the appropriate ticket when purchasing.

Are minors allowed at the nightly cabarets/concerts?

Yes. Minors are allowed, but they must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is 19+.

Can I buy tickets at the gate?

We recommend purchasing online in advance to guarantee entry. Gate sales are not guaranteed.

Is there any food included in my ticket price?

No. All food, including pancake breakfasts, is the responsibility of attendees. The kitchen in the Sportsplex will be open, food trucks will be on site, and local restaurants will be available.

Are tickets refundable?

Tickets are non-refundable, but they are transferable.

What is the schedule?
